VA'S COMMITTMENT

- VA LTSS encompass a broad range of assistance to Veterans regardless of age who
 have lost the ability to function independently thus preventing them from being active
 participants in their communities.
- Projections over the next decade indicate there will be about one million Veterans 85 and older who will most likely require LTSS.








VA SYSTEM STRUCTURE WITH LTSS







VAMC RESPONSIBILITIES



Sends all referrals with:

- Geriatric Extended Care Assessment
- Completed Case Mix
- Proposed Budget
- Veteran has already been informed of program



AIS'S ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES



The Options Counselor:

- Act as liaison between Veteran, FMS and VA SW
- Provide fiscal oversight
- Ensure program integrity
- Provides person centered advocacy
- Helps Veteran to identify & understand their needs



WHO LTSS IS BEING PROVIDED FOR



ON AVERAGE

- Have 6 ADL Dependencies
- Have an average budget of \$3206/Mo
- 50% of Veterans referred meet criteria for "High Needs"
- 67% of Veterans referred have Dementia
 - Other Medical Issues include: CHF, Depression, PTSD

 - 3 Month & Annual




- Utilization data review
 - Compared services provided to Veterans from the VA prior to SD-VISA enrollment and after SD-VISA enrollment.
 - Reviewed hospital readmissions, SNF respite, Homemaker/Home Health Program and SNF Diversion


COMPARISON: VASDHS vs. SD-VISA




HOURS OF CARE
